

## Risk Assessment Policy

### AIM

The application of robust risk assessing alongside common sense will ensure that all children and staff are safe enough whilst enjoying all the physical and diverse challenges of playing in and outside of the nursery. Risks can not be eliminated altogether but they can be minimised so there is a balance of health and safety assessment with the potential benefits of any activity.

Dynamic on-going risk assessments occur as unexpected challenges take place in a session.

There are three elements to the assessment:

- \* Benefit - the positive outcomes of the experience / planned activities
- \* Hazard - the potential for something to cause harm
- \* Risk - the likelihood of it happening
